

# WHAT TO DO IF YOU TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 OR HAVE SYMPTOMS

## ? Students and Staff Regardless of Vaccination Status



- Stay home and isolate from other people for at least 5 full days. Day 0 is the first day symptoms began or the day your positive COVID-19 test was taken (if you do not have symptoms).



- Separate yourself from others, including those in your household.



- Wear a well-fitting mask around others, including those in your household.

After 5 days, do you still have a fever or other symptoms that haven't started to get better?

You can end isolation and return to school and other activities. Continue to wear a mask around others at home and in public for an additional 5 days.



Stay home until you have been fever free for 24 hours and other symptoms have improved. Continue to wear a mask in public and around household members for an additional 5 days.

Day Symptoms Begin or Positive COVID-19 Test was Taken

Return to School. Wear Mask for 5 Days.



If you have symptoms of COVID-19 and are waiting for your test results, stay home until you get your test results. If you have questions about when to return to school or if you test positive, contact your school.
