

January 2012 Delivery Delays, Updates and Cancellations

Update: 100046, whole liquid eggs (A568) – DPI finally received some of the whole liquid eggs for the State of Wisconsin. Therefore, schools will receive January 2012 orders. In addition, the January 2012 orders will include back-order amounts for November 2011 and the December 2011, as well. The October 2011 back-order amounts will remain on back-order and will be filled along with February 2012 order amounts. No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for October 2011, November 2011, December 2011 or January 2012 delivery.

Delay: 100125, turkey roasts (A537) – DPI only received a partial shipment of turkey roasts for the month of January 2012. Therefore, schools may receive **none or less than** the amounts originally requested for January 2012 delivery. If DPI receives the January 2012 back-order amounts in time for February 2012 delivery, schools will receive the January 2012 back-order amounts in February 2012 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for February 2012). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for January 2012 or February 2012.

Delay: 100158, ground beef (A608) – DPI only received a partial shipment of fine ground beef for the month of January 2012. Therefore, schools may receive **none or less than** the amounts originally requested for January 2012 delivery. If DPI receives the January 2012 back-order amounts in time for February 2012 delivery, schools will receive the January 2012 back-order amounts in February 2012 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for February 2012). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for January 2012 or February 2012.

Update: 100212, mixed fruit (A470) – DPI received some mixed fruit for the month of January 2012. Therefore, some schools will receive their January 2012 mixed fruit orders in full. However, DPI still did not receive enough to fill the December 2011 back-order amounts of mixed fruit. Therefore, the December 2011 orders and the remaining January 2012 orders will remain on back-order. If DPI receives these back-order amounts in time for February 2012, these back-order amounts will be filled in February 2012 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for February 2012). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for December 2011 or January 2012 delivery.

Delay: 100220, diced peaches (A409) – DPI only received a partial shipment of fine diced peaches for the month of January 2012. Therefore, schools may receive **none or less than** the amounts originally requested for January 2012 delivery. If DPI receives the January 2012 back-order amounts in time for February 2012 delivery, schools will receive the January 2012 back-order amounts in February 2012 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for February 2012). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for January 2012 or February 2012.

Update: 100225, diced pears (A434) – DPI received the back-order amounts of diced pears. Therefore, the January 2012 orders will include the November 2011 and December 2011 back-order amounts (in addition to the amounts originally requested for January 2012). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for November 2011, December 2011 or January 2012 delivery.

Cancellation: 100313, canned corn (A110) – Due to crop shortages, USDA has cancelled several trucks of canned corn for the state of Wisconsin. Therefore, DPI received enough canned corn to fill orders for part of January 2012. All remaining orders of corn beyond this have been cancelled in the Wisconsin USDA Foods ordering

system. Therefore, please access the “Survey” tab in Program Year 2012 of the Wisconsin USDA Foods Ordering System to view these adjustments.

Update: 100352, frozen carrots (A099) –For schools serviced by VersaCold Logistic Services, DPI received the December 2011 back-order amounts. Therefore, for schools serviced by VersaCold Logistic Services, the January 2012 orders will include the December 2011 back-order amounts (in addition to the amounts originally requested for January 2012). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for December 2011 or January 2012 delivery.

Delay: 100355, potato wedges (A174) - Due to the late harvest of potato crops, there continues to be a delay in shipment of potato orders. Therefore, USDA has still not purchased **any** potato wedges for the state of Wisconsin. At this time, the back-order amounts for December 2011 and January 2012 will remain on back-order. DPI will provide additional information on this, as it becomes available from USDA.

Delay: 100358, potato rounds (A204) – USDA is continuing to have difficulty in purchasing of potato rounds. Therefore, very few schools will receive any potato rounds for the month of January 2012. If the January 2012 back-order amounts arrive in time for February 2012 delivery, DPI will ship the January 2012 back-order amounts in February 2012 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for February 2012). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for January 2012 or February 2012.

Delay: 100362, refried beans (A085) – Due to a delay at the vendor, DPI did not receive any refried beans for January 2012 deliveries. If DPI receives the January 2012 back-order amounts in time for February 2012 delivery, schools will receive the January 2012 back-order amounts in February 2012 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for February 2012). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for January 2012 or February 2012 delivery.

Delay: 100396, peanut butter (B473) – For schools serviced by Central Storage and Warehouse – Eau Claire, DPI only received a partial shipment of peanut butter. Therefore, these schools may receive **none or less than** the amounts originally requested for January 2012 delivery. If DPI receives the January 2012 back-order amounts in time for February 2012 delivery, schools will receive the January 2012 back-order amounts in February 2012 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for February 2012). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested in January 2012 or February 2012.

Delay: 100500, brown rice (B537) – DPI only received a partial shipment of brown rice for the month of January 2012. Therefore, these schools may receive **none or less than** the amounts originally requested for January 2012 delivery. If DPI receives the January 2012 back-order amounts in time for February 2012 delivery, schools will receive the January 2012 back-order amounts in February 2012 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for February 2012). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested in January 2012 or February 2012.

Delay: 110080, oven-roasted chicken (A494) – USDA is again behind on purchasing of the oven-roasted chicken. Therefore, schools will not receive any oven-roasted chicken until **February 2012 or later**. If the back-order amounts arrive in time for February 2012 delivery, DPI will fill the October 2011, December 2011 and January 2012 back-order amounts in **February 2012**. No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for October 2011, December 2011, January 2012 or February 2012 delivery.

Delay: C305, turkey deli breast – DPI only received a partial shipment of turkey deli breast for the month of January 2012. Therefore, schools may receive **none or less than** the amounts originally requested for January 2012 delivery. If DPI receives the January 2012 back-order amounts in time for February 2012 delivery, schools will receive the January 2012 back-order amounts in February 2012 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for February 2012). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested in January 2012 or February 2012.
