

November 2009 Delivery Delays, Updates & Cancellations

Canned Corn (A110) Update

DPI received the back-orders of A110, canned corn originally intended for **October 2009** delivery to schools. Therefore, schools will receive the October 2009 back-orders in **November 2009** (in addition to the amounts originally requested for November 2009 delivery). No school adjustments can be made for the amounts originally ordered for October 2009 delivery.

Canned Apricot (A382) Cancellations

Due to lack of supply, USDA was unable to purchase a large portion of the A382, canned apricot orders. Therefore, schools **will not** be receiving **any** canned apricots for **November 2009 and December 2009** deliveries. In addition, only some of the **January 2010** delivery orders will be filled.

DPI has made the adjustments for the **November 2009 through January 2010 cancellations** in the Commodity Internet System. Schools may view these adjustments by accessing the "Survey" tab for Program Year 2010 in the Commodity Internet System.

Diced Chicken (A517) Delays

Due to funding issues at USDA, USDA is continuing to delay purchases of A517, diced chicken. DPI did receive enough A517, diced chicken to fill **all** of the **November 2009** and **some** of the **October 2009 back-orders** for schools serviced by Central Storage and Warehouse – Eau Claire. However, DPI only received enough A517, diced chicken to fill **some** of the November 2009 orders for schools serviced by Geneva Lakes Cold Storage. Therefore, schools serviced by Geneva Lakes Cold Storage may receive **none or less than** the amounts originally ordered for **November 2009** deliveries. Additional delays for future months are likely to occur. DPI will provide additional information on the diced chicken delays as updates are received from USDA.

Breaded Chicken (A526) Delays

Due to funding issues at USDA and vendor capacity issues, USDA has been unable to purchase any A526, breaded chicken for the state of Wisconsin. Therefore, schools will receive **no** A526, breaded chicken for **November 2009 deliveries**. USDA is still working out the details regarding when and if A526, breaded chicken will be purchased for the state of Wisconsin. Once USDA has provided additional information regarding the breaded chicken, DPI will provide an update.

Turkey Roast (A537) Delays

USDA delayed the purchase of A537, turkey roasts. Therefore, schools will receive **no** A537, turkey roasts for the month of **November 2009**. If DPI receives the November 2009 back-order amounts in time for December 2009 delivery, DPI will fill the November 2009 back orders for December 2009 delivery (in addition to the amounts originally requested for December 2009 delivery). No school adjustments can be made for the amounts originally ordered for November 2009 delivery.

Whole Frozen Eggs (A568) Update

DPI received the back-orders of A568, whole frozen eggs originally intended for **October 2009** delivery to schools. Therefore, schools will receive the October 2009 back-orders in **November 2009** (in addition to the amounts originally requested for November 2009 delivery). No school adjustments can be made for the amounts originally ordered for October 2009 delivery.

Turkey Mini Corn Dog (C306) Delay

USDA delayed the purchase of several trucks of bulk turkey intended for processing into the C306, turkey mini corn dogs for November delivery to schools. Therefore, schools may receive **none or less than** the amounts originally intended for **November 2009** delivery. Additional delays may occur for future months. DPI will provide additional information on the turkey mini corn dog delays as updates are received.

Bonus Orange Juice Cups (C910b) Cancellations

USDA was unable to purchase all of the bonus bulk orange juice requested by the state of Wisconsin. Therefore, schools **will not** be receiving **any** bonus orange juice cups for **November 2009** delivery.
