

November 2011 Delivery Delays, Updates and Cancellations

Delay: 100046, whole liquid eggs (A568) - Due to high prices over the summer, USDA still has not purchased any whole liquid eggs for the state of Wisconsin. Therefore, schools will receive **no** whole liquid eggs until **December 2011 or later**. If the back-order amounts arrive in time for December 2011 delivery, DPI will fill the October 2011 and November 2011 back-order amounts in December 2011. No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for October 2011 or November 2011 delivery.

Update: 100158, ground beef (A608) – The back-order amounts of ground beef from October 2011 arrived. Therefore, schools will receive the October 2011 back-order amounts in November 2011 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for November 2011 delivery). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for October 2011 or November 2011 delivery.

Update: 100187, sliced ham (A726) – The back-order amounts of sliced ham from October 2011 arrived. Therefore, schools will receive the October 2011 back-order amounts in November 2011 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for November 2011 delivery). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for October 2011 or November 2011 delivery.

Update: 100219, sliced peaches (A408) – For schools serviced out of Central Storage & Warehouse – Eau Claire, the back-order amounts of sliced peaches from October 2011 arrived. Therefore, schools will receive the October 2011 back-order amounts in November 2011 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for November 2011 delivery). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for October 2011 or November 2011 delivery.

Update: 100220, diced peaches (A409) – For schools serviced out of Central Storage & Warehouse – Eau Claire, the back-order amounts of diced peaches from October 2011 arrived. Therefore, schools will receive the October 2011 back-order amounts in November 2011 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for November 2011 delivery). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for October 2011 or November 2011 delivery.

Update: 10225, diced pears (A434) – Due to a delay at the processor, DPI only received a partial shipment of diced pears for November 2011 delivery. Therefore, schools may receive **none or less than** the amounts originally requested for November 2011 delivery. If the back-order amounts arrive in time for December 2011 delivery, DPI will fill the October 2011 back-order amounts in December 2011 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for December 2011 delivery). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for October 2011 or November 2011 delivery.

Delay: 100330, salsa (A237) – Due to late harvest of tomato crops, there is a delay in shipment of salsa orders. Therefore, schools will receive **no** salsa until **December 2011 delivery or later**. If the back-order amounts arrive in time for December 2011 delivery, DPI will fill the October 2011 and November 2011 back-order amounts in December 2011 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for December 2011 delivery). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for October 2011 or November 2011 delivery.

Cancellation: 100355, potato wedges (A174) - Due to the late harvest of potato crops, there continues to be a delay in shipment of potato orders. Therefore, schools will receive no potato wedges until **December 2011 or later**. In addition, due to the

extended delay, the decision was made to **cancel** the **October 2011 and November 2011** back-order amounts. DPI has made the entitlement adjustments for the October 2011 and November 2011 order cancellations. Therefore, please access the "Survey" tab in Program Year 2012 of the Wisconsin USDA Foods Ordering System to view these adjustments.

Update: 100358, potato rounds (A204) – DPI finally received several shipments of potato rounds. The potato rounds received are sufficient to cover all of the November 2011 delivery orders and a portion of the October 2011 back-order amounts. Therefore, the November 2011 delivery orders include a portion of the October 2011 back-order amounts (in addition to the amounts originally requested for November 2011 delivery). If the remaining back-order amounts arrive in time for December 2011 delivery, DPI will fill the remaining October 2011 back-order amounts in December 2011. No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for October 2011 or November 2011 delivery.

Update: 101022, whole grain pancakes – For the month of November 2011, schools will again receive the 101022, whole grain pancakes, instead of the 100937, whole grain pancakes originally ordered for November delivery. Update: 110080, oven-roasted chicken (A494) – DPI finally received several shipments of oven-roasted chicken. The oven-roasted chicken received is sufficient to cover all of the November 2011 delivery orders. Unfortunately, it was not sufficient to cover the October 2011 back-order amounts. If the back-order amounts arrive in time for December 2011 delivery, DPI will fill the October 2011 back-order amounts in December 2011 (in addition to the amounts originally requested for December 2011 delivery). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for October 2011 for November 2011 delivery.

Delay: C453, 2.5 oz. pb&j sandwiches/soy – Due to an issue at the processor, DPI does not have any C453, 2.5 oz. pb&J sandwiches/soy available for November 2011 delivery. Therefore, schools **will not** receive any C453 for **November 2011** deliveries. If the back-order amounts arrive in time for December 2011 delivery, DPI will fill the November 2011 back-order amounts in December 2011 (in addition to the amount originally requested for December 2011 delivery). No adjustments can be made to the amounts originally requested for November 2011 delivery.
