“Preparing & Planning for ACP Leadership” Conference

Description:

The first annual DPI sponsored Academic and Career Planning (ACP) conference is intended to provide school districts and their partners with foundational connections for planning, preparing and leading ACP efforts. Conference topics planned are based on the 2015 analysis of ACP needs by the Wisconsin Center for Education Research (WCER) collected from surveys and focus groups of district and building leaders. This year the conference focus is on planning and preparation with presentations for building capacity to deliver ACP services.

Strands:

The conference features five strands, or common themes, of sessions. It is envisioned that district teams send staff to as many sessions as possible to gain a broader perspective of ACP.

- **Intro to ACP-** Intended for school districts not chosen as ACP pilot schools. These three sessions build on each other and are a great way to participate in activities to learn the basics of ACP planning and preparation just as the pilot school teams did this past summer.
- **ACP Pilot District Panels-** Panels from our ACP pilot districts will discuss their ACP planning and implementation experiences as they relate to starting point, readiness, goal setting, challenges, and successes in their particular areas.
- **Curricular Connections-** This set of sessions is intended to help a school district to connect other ongoing strategic district work to ACP.
- **Resources for ACP Delivery-** Session topics describe other resources available that will be helpful as school districts plan and leverage connections for ACP implementation.
- **Personalizing ACP-** At the core of the ACP vision is the connection to the student driving a vision of their future. These sessions will present topics related to student choices and opportunities.
