

TECH BULLETIN: Maximizing COS - SD Performance for Wisconsin Forward Testing

Summary

Some districts with high testing volume have been experiencing testing issues due to Central Office Services - Service Device (COS - SD) performance and CPU bandwidth. This is a result of larger testing files downloaded to COS - SDs that now include TTS on all forms.

In order to maximize COS - SD performance to alleviate Content Hosting slowdowns, DRC recommends:

- Adding another COS - SD to your COS Configuration

- Increasing the CPU capacity of your COS - SD(s)
 - Add an additional vCPU to a virtual COS - SD server
 - Only use the COS - SD for testing, and disable or close any other process-intensive applications
- Staggering testing logins
