Good Afternoon, District Assessment Coordinators.

Last week the Wisconsin Senate passed SB 67, the so-called “holiday” or “pause” bill, which would place a one-year hold on School Report Cards and delay for one year the use of assessment results in Educator Effectiveness. **A similar bill (AB 78) has not yet been voted on by the Assembly.**

As of this writing, **School Report Cards will be issued** for the 2014-15 school year. This may change in the coming weeks as the Wisconsin Legislature continues to debate issues relating to school accountability. DPI will continue to update you as new information becomes available.
