

CACFP Eligibility Assessment

You selected,

"I operate an emergency shelter, At-Risk Afterschool Program or Outside of School Hours Care Center and my organization has tax exempt status or is a public entity"

Because your facility is not licensed, in order to participate on the CACFP you will have to obtain the following Health and Safety Standards:

1. Occupancy permit for each site, or a letter from the local housing authority indicating that the site(s) is located in a residential area and therefore an occupancy permit is not required by local statute
2. Fire inspection report or a letter from the local fire marshal detailing how often the site(s) must be inspected, or a letter from the applicable fire department certifying that the site(s) does not require a fire inspection
3. Health department inspection or a letter from the City or County Health Department certifying that there are no local health standards which are applicable to the site(s)
4. A form from the Department of Children and Families certifying that there is no requirement for the site(s) to be licensed or certified for the provision of child care services
