You must meet the following requirements:

 Applicant does not need to be a JA student.
- Owner(s) or manager(s) of a private or public company. Business may be seasonal and must have been in operation since April 29, 2019. Multiple owners will equally share the scholarship/cash prize. The business must have been created by the applicant(s), whom must have had continuity of ownership/management throughout the existence of the business.
- You not a previous winner of this award.

Award and Recognition:

One winner will receive a scholarship or cash prize of \$1,000. Winner will also be recognized at the Wisconsin Business Hall of Fame™ Induction Ceremony. Scholarships may be applied toward expenses at any (post-secondary) educational institution. Financial awards will be mailed directly to the institution in the award recipient's name. The winning applicant will be featured on the DPI Young Entrepreneur of the Year webpage.

Judging Criteria:

A winner will be chosen based on business success, growth potential, and social involvement. The selection committee also considers the entrepreneur's age when the business was started and any special challenges that had to be faced, strategic direction, innovation, personal integrity, and leadership.
