

**Carryover Provisions for  
 Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) Covered Programs**

Following is a table describing the carryover provisions for the covered programs of ESEA. Local educational agencies (LEAs) are strongly encouraged to expend dollars in the year they were allocated.

Title I, Part A	LEAs with Allocations* Less than \$50,000	No provision for limitation of carryover in the federal law. DPI encourages LEAs to spend the money in the year in which it was allocated but will allow LEAs to carryover up to 100% of their prior year's allocation.	<a href="#">Title I Consultant Directory</a>
	LEAs with Allocations* Greater than \$50,000	May carryover 15% of the unobligated funds into the succeeding fiscal year.  LEAs must apply for a waiver to carryover more than 15% of the total allocation. This is only allowed once every three years. Click <a href="#">here</a> for more information.
