Thank you for submitting Wisconsin's "ESEA Flexibility Accountability Addendum" (Accountability Addendum) for review. I appreciate the efforts that were required to prepare the Accountability Addendum, which replaces Wisconsin's existing accountability workbook under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended (ESEA). In conjunction with Wisconsin's approved ESEA flexibility request, the Accountability Addendum provides comprehensive information regarding the elements of Wisconsin's system of differentiated recognition, accountability and support.

U.S. Department of Education (Department) staff have completed a review of Wisconsin's Accountability Addendum and found that it provides the requisite information. Accordingly, I am pleased to approve Wisconsin's Accountability Addendum. If, over time, Wisconsin makes changes to its accountability system that affect what is included in the Accountability Addendum, you must submit information about those changes to the Department for approval.

Please be aware that approval of Wisconsin's Accountability Addendum does not indicate that it complies with Federal civil rights requirements, including Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act, and requirements under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
