Equipment Bin Directions	Equipment List
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Participants will bring with them a minimum of one 8-inch cake. Cakes may be irregular in shape and can be one or two layers. Cakes may be crumb coated, but should otherwise be undecorated. 2. Each participant must have their own equipment and bins, they cannot be shared between participants. 3. Equipment listed is suggested, not required. Items not listed on this list are not allowed and will be removed by the room consultant at the time of competition. 4. Equipment in bins must be clean. 5. Frostings or baked products should not be stored in the equipment bin. 6. Participants are allowed to bring a small cooler with them at the time of competition to house their cupcakes, cakes, and/or buttercream. 7. Equipment bins and coolers should be labeled on the top and both ends with the participant's name, school, and city. 8. Hair nets, aprons, and chef hats should not be packed in the equipment bin. They should be brought at the time of competition. 9. At the conclusion of competition all items from the equipment bins and finished products should be taken with the participant from the competition room. 10. State Leadership Conference: All equipment bins should be dropped off in the Mangrove room at the Kalahari Convention Center on Monday, April 8th prior to the Opening Session. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Up to 5 colored buttercream frostings, colored in advance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Fondant and royal frosting are not allowed ● Disposable frosting bags ● Up to 5 decorator tips of choice with couplers ● Flower or rose nail, if needed ● Box of wooden toothpicks ● (2) 6-inch metal spatulas/spreaders ● (2) 10-inch metal spatulas/spreaders ● 4 rubber scrapers ● Up to 5 spoons of choice to transfer frosting to bags ● 12-ounce plastic cup or bowl for water for dipping/rinsing ● Kitchen or pastry shears ● Paring knife ● Acrylic cutting board ● Small strainer/sifter ● Cake stand ● 2 white, round dessert/salad plates ● 2 washcloths ● 4 dish towels ● 1 roll of wax paper, parchment paper, or freezer paper ● 1 roll of paper towel ● 1 box of NSF food grade disposable gloves ● Digital or manual timer ● Writing utensil ● Spray bottle of food safe sanitizer in sealed bag ● Additional decorative materials may include: piping gel, edible glitter, sprinkles, materials for painting/drawing. No commercially manufactured ornaments allowed (example: plastic balloon bunch topper)
