Basic STAR Event Information

State STAR Events: These events compete at regionals and at State Leadership Conference for those that advance, but **do not advance to Nationals**. Participants in these events strive to earn the Wisconsin Top Gold Award, meaning they received the highest score at the State Leadership Conference.

National STAR Events: These events compete at regionals, state conferences for those that advance, and if they earn one of the top two scores at State Leadership Conference they will advance to Nationals.

Level 2- Grades 9-10

Level 3- Grades 11-12

If you have students competing as a team, but qualify under different age levels, they must register for the higher of the levels. For example, if you have a 10th grader and an 11th grader competing together on a team, they must be registered as a Level 3.

Individual events allow only one participant per entry. Participants compete solo.

Team events allow up to three participants to compete as a team. Parliamentary Procedure allows up to eight participants to compete as a team.
