# Quick Guide to Using

# American Rescue Plan-Homeless Children and Youth (ARP-HCY) Grant Funds

All ARP-HCY funds must be used (obligated) by September 30, 2024. For a comprehensive review of allowable activities, please see information on the <u>https://dpi.wi.gov/homeless/arp-hcy</u> webpage and the <u>ARP-HCY Frequently Asked Questions</u> document.

## With less than 6 months before September 30th, here are a few easy ways to spend funds:

### **District level services:**

- Salaries of staff working directly with students experiencing homelessness (homeless liaison, social worker, academic mentors/tutors, etc.)
  - Extended contract hours, summer hours
- Training and outreach
  - Registration for the <u>NAEHCY conference</u> (when purchased before 9/30/2024)
  - Printing costs for fliers, brochures, posters, etc.
- Transportation Excess cost of school of origin transportation
  - Sharing the cost of bussing or transportation with another district
  - o Gas cards/mileage reimbursement for families/youth
  - Taxi/ride share, public transportation
  - Purchase of a district vehicle to transport students experiencing homelessness.

### Direct student services:

- Supplies and clothing
  - School supply items (backpacks, calculators, etc.)
  - Hygiene items (laundry detergent, hair care products, deodorant, etc.)
  - Apparel (shoes, winter clothing/gear, graduation cap and gown, etc.)
- Health services
  - o Mental health, medical and dental services (eyeglasses, immunizations, etc.)
- Participation and extracurricular fees (if not otherwise covered by district policies)
- College preparation activities (college application fees, AP exam fees)
- Emergency, short-term hotel stays (please see the <u>ARP-HCY FAQ</u> for more information)
