 - ✓ Receive transportation to the school of origin while homeless if feasible.
 - ✓ Enroll in school without a permanent address and attend classes while the school seeks immunization records or other documents required for enrollment.
 - ✓ Receive the same special programs and services, if needed, as provided to all other children served in these programs.
 - ✓ Have enrollment disputes quickly addressed.
 - ✓ Remain in the same school for the entire school year, even if becomes permanently housed (without transportation)
