Date	Item/Event
April 13	Spring Training for Directors
May 11	Spring Training for Recruiters
August 31	2015-16 <b>Regular Term Application</b> due.
August 31	2014-15 Regular Term <b>End-of-Year Report</b> due.
10 days after summer program ends	2015 Summer Term <b>End-of-Year Report</b> due. (MEP grants only <u>not</u> Math MATTERS)
September 30	<b>Continuing Enrollment Report (CER)</b> due. This is a good time to verify each student has a current COE on file.
As students withdraw	Regular year <b>Student Reporting Forms (SRF)</b> due.
