B = Biennial: budget authority lapses to the state's general fund at the end of the biennium

C = Continuing: unused budget authority does not lapse to the state's general fund (it carries over to next fiscal year)

S = Sum Sufficient: the appropriation pays the full amount of aid eligibility or expenditures under the statute (i.e., the amounts in the chapter 20 schedule are estimates)
