IEP Forms Change Summary 2023-24

IEP: Linking Form (I-4)

- We added links to the forms guide to provide IEP teams with access to guidance;
- We provided more information regarding progress monitoring methods to reflect that the purpose is to enable the team to make ongoing decisions and to report progress to parents;
- We added intervener to the list of related services;
- We provided more explanation to the prompt of whether the student needs assistive technology so that IEP teams would be encouraged to think more broadly; and
- We revised student participation prompts to reduce redundancy with the placement forms.

Determination and Notice of Placement (P-1 and P-2)

- We distinguished prompts for location and environment; and
- Revised to reduce redundancy with the I-4 form.

Disability Category Criteria Forms

- Revisions to better explain requirements for each disability category during a reevaluation;
- Form ER-1-BVI we revised instructions for IEP team members;
- Form ER-1-DHH we revised instructions for IEP team members and streamlined prompts for considering educational performance; and
- Form ER-2-C SLD form using significant discrepancy we clarified language when considering inadequate classroom achievement.
