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School Safety Scores (final term yet to be determined)

- 9 YRBS elements will make up 50% of score/index
- Discipline data to make up other 50% of score
- Means of the two raw scores for all 69 high schools will be determined, and a multiplier will be applied to the lower score that will allow for each to comprise 50% of total
- Same formula and multiplier will be used to determine scores for each school throughout the duration of the project.
