Data and Information Systems



Developing statewide technology is part of Wisconsin's strategy to help every child graduate ready for college and career. These new digital systems will give the state a higher value for its investment in education by:

- managing costs,
- enhancing students' education using current technology,
- equalizing opportunities for all schools,
- making it easier to consult education data, and
- saving time for teachers and other staff.

The Statewide Student Information System (SSIS) is the core solution that allows schools to do their work using technology. In this system, students are enrolled, attendance taken, grades recorded, and class schedules built, among other tasks. The Wisconsin Department of Administration is currently working with knowledgeable staff from Wisconsin schools to choose a vendor which will create a SSIS for districts across the state. Implementation should begin in 2013.

The Wisconsin Information System for Education (WISE) is where much of the data about PK-12 education will reside. Teachers and Administrators will access this information through the WISEdash website, and use it to help them make decisions that are good for kids. The "dashboards" and reports in WISEdash are being provided to groups of Wisconsin school districts in

phases beginning in 2012. After pilot-testing, parents and the public will be able to access it as well.

We have selected an open-source **Learning Management System (LMS)** and will deploy it statewide. This software allows educators across the state to create or share high quality lesson plans with each other in an easily searchable environment. Having this system will help to prevent duplication of effort and will open the door to e-textbooks and other digital curriculum. In addition, students will be able to use the LMS to connect with teachers elsewhere in Wisconsin for online coursework.

We are developing an **Educator Licensing Online (ELO)** system to make it easier and faster for teachers to obtain licenses and we are implementing an electronic process to help teachers meet Professional Development Plan (PDP) requirements for renewal. The licensing system will also capture valuable data that will help educators, school districts, and teacher preparation and training providers to best meet the needs of Wisconsin students.

The DPI plans to develop a **one-stop Wisconsin portal**, employing the latest search technologies, to help educators more quickly identify quality resources and professional development opportunities. Educators will also be able to share techniques and mentor each other in this online space, using communication features similar to a standard social network.

Assessments and Data Systems

How do we know if they learned it?

- Change state assessment proficiency levels, to reflect the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP), providing **higher expectations for students** that reflect career and college readiness;
- Implement an online, adaptive **next generation assessment** system that **gauges student progress throughout the year**, and provides real-time data to teachers and parents;
- **Measure student college and career readiness** from the end of middle school through high school using the EXPLORE/PLAN/ACT tests and WorkKeys; and
- **Launch statewide student information and data systems that support districts, streamline operations, and expand research.**

WISEdash General Overview

Why WISEdash?

- Provide an integrated educational analysis and reporting system to support
 - School and district staff making **decisions** to improve student achievement
 - Parents and community members **learning** more about their schools
 - **Accurate** and **timely** data reporting to meet Federal, State, and local requirements
 - Analytical and policy-relevant **research**
- Statewide, integrated, consistent

Why WISEdash?

Ultimately, we aim to increase data-informed decision-making at the state, district, school, classroom, and student level

WISEdash, powered by Edvantage

- Spans **multiple subject areas** throughout Education to enable smart, comprehensive analysis on education data
- **Stores and links** student and school data from a variety of sources.
- Role based **access to data & dashboards**
- **Public and secured dashboards** through the same technology to a wide variety of users with a wide variety of data needs
- **Simple ad hoc reporting** functionality (choose a district, choose a demographic)
- **Advanced reporting** capabilities for a limited number of power users at the district and state level to create customizable reports (*Future Functionality*)
- Documentation, including professional development resources such as pre-made **workbooks to guide understanding** and use of dashboards and reports
- Opportunity for **collaboration** with districts and WI research organizations

WISEdash

- Piloted WISEdash to several districts in June/July with positive feedback
- Statewide rollout announced in September
- **Intended Users:** School and district staff interested in accessing a variety of dashboards and reports populated with their district/school data
- **Secure release only:** log in required and available only to school and district staff

WISEdash

- Dashboards available initially in Fall 2012 include Enrollments, Attendance, WSAS, ACT, AP, and Student Growth Percentiles.
- Dashboards added 1st quarter 2013 include Postsecondary Enrollment, HS Completion, and ACCESS for ELL
- Guided Analysis available for WSAS and SGP
- Student data displayed starting with the 2005-06 school year

WISEdash

- **3 levels of access** based on legitimate educational need
- Ability (based on role assigned)
 - to drill from a chart on a dashboard to a student list and ultimately a student profile
 - to view a student profile
 - to search for an individual student
- Uses **Secure Home** and ASM like the other secure tools.
- Definitions and comments are available directly through the tool.

Wisconsin's Information Network for Successful Schools (WINSS) is a resource for educators, parents, and the public interested in educating the hearts and minds of Wisconsin's children. WINSS provides information on how to know and be able to do; how students are performing each year; and how our schools are staffed. WINSS also shares the seven characteristics of successful schools - and shares resources that are central to successful schools: data analysis, standards and assessment, school improvement, and best practices; professional development and community partnerships.



WISEdash topics

- WINSS will be phased out over time
- First dashboard topics available will be Enrollment, Attendance, WSAS, ACT, and AP (red box).
 - Student data from 2005-06 school year
 - Historical (pre-2005) WINSS data available
 - All datasets will be summarized and redacted.
- WISElearn project or others will adopt the other 3 boxes.
- After the public launch, planning will begin to implement additional data topics.

WISEdash redaction

- **No student-level data on WISEdash**
- **Redaction** is an algorithm applied to WISEdash data sets so that discovery of personally identifiable information is minimized.

Direct disclosure occurs when data could be linked to a specific student that a reasonable person in the community could identify with reasonable certainty. Prevented by using a “cell size” of no less than 5 students.

Indirect disclosure occurs when redacted data could be combined with other aggregated data to deduce personally identifiable information.



Current Timeline

- Soft release to DPI staff in the summer.
- Public release planned based on information gathered and feedback received during the soft release.
- The timeline for WISElearn is TBD.

WISEdash - the Wisconsin Information System for Education Dashboard - is the next step in the Department of Public Instruction's transformation of the way education data can be used by schools in the state, tapping into the data in the state's data warehouse. Drawing on a wealth of information about student progress, districts, schools and educators will be able to make better decisions to help every child graduate ready for higher education and the workforce.
