**Expulsion Resolution**

The school board, by this resolution, intends to create a more efficient process to handle the potential removal of students who commit expellable offenses.

The school board delegates the responsibility of conducting individual expulsion hearings to a panel of three board members appointed using a method determined by the board president with advice of the superintendent.

The panel will vote on the expulsion, determine the length of the expulsion, any early reinstatement conditions that the student must meet prior to reinstatement or before the expiration of the term of expulsion and authorize the administration to notify the parents in accordance with policy and state law. Any expulsion will be in effect immediately following the hearing upon written notice to the parent and student.

Within 30 days of the issuance of the order, the full school board will receive a summary report from the panel's hearing and shall review the expulsion order and shall approve, reverse or modify the order. An action to approve the order(s) may be taken in open or closed session. Any parental appeal to the state superintendent of the expulsion decision shall be made after the full school board's review and decision.

This resolution shall be renewed annually and shall be in effect for the school year for which it was adopted.
