



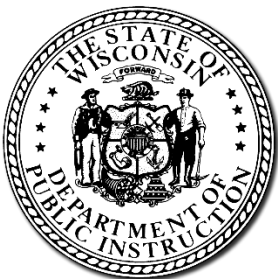
Proclamation
