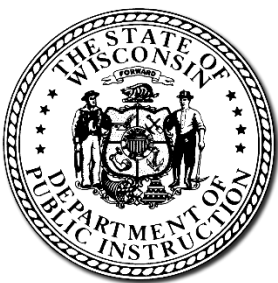


Teacher Appreciation Week
