# STAKEHOLDER COLLABORATION

- Frequency: monthly for 6 months
- Comprised of
  - MMSD – Lead Social Workers
  - DCDHS - CPS & YJ – Supervisors and Social Workers
  - Juvenile Judge and Juvenile Attorney
- Smaller workgroup came out of that meeting
  - Focus on Mandated Supporting
    - How to best support families rather than reporting to CPS or YJ

# MMSD COLLABORATION

- From Mandated Reporting to Mandated Supporting
  - Attendance is a signal!
  - Truancy Petition Timeline
    - collaboration with the leads
    - meeting with county
    - training for social workers
- Attendance Works Collaboration
  - Attendance School Improvement Plan Goal(s)
  - School team(s): Cross department roles (psychologist, social worker, MTSS, administration, teacher, counselor, pbis, additional roles)
  - Data: daily, weekly, and monthly pull
  - Tiers:
    - Tier 1: Attendance communication and assemblies
    - Tier 2: Team support, attendance support plans
    - Tier 3: Tailored individual support

# GIRLS GROUP

- 16 MMSD Freshman and Sophomore Girls
  - Half of these were school social worker referrals.
  - Youth participating from West, Capital, and La Follette High Schools.
- Proactive girls group
  - Current group topics involve determining group logistics, and then addressing wellness topics including self-care and confidence, healthy relationships, conflict navigation, and healthy habits.
- Wraparound support
  - Girls now connected to more diverse programming and adult supports.
