Introduction

- Much of the focus is on changes from year 1 (2013-14) to year 2 (2014-15) to year 3 (2015-16)
- Year 1 is our "baseline" year
 - True baseline would be 2012-13, however that is not possible across all sites
 - Year 1 is approximated at ~70% of the year spent in active implementation across sites.


• Year 1(2013-14) = 622

• Year 3(2015-16) = 621








Case Management Contacts (this year)








Credit Success Rate

Assumes that...reasons for missing school when pregnant or parenting are constant between years






ACT Scores


AAPI-2

- Results look at matched pairs (n=337)
 - -Comparison of baseline with most recent administration

- Goals
 - Minimize percent in high risk category
 - Maximize percent in low risk category




Domain: Expectation






Domain: Empathy






Domain: Corporal Punishment






Domain: Family Roles





Review

Positives:

- Increasing case management contacts from baseline
- Drop-outs at project low
- ACT Scores (increase by 1 full point between 13/14 and 14/15)
- AAPI-2 scores have positive changes

Items to look deeper at:

- Graduation and attendance rates changed minimally
- Credit success rate at project low
