

UW-Stout Undergraduate or Graduate Credit for ACP Leadership Conference

UW-Stout is offering a two-credit course, CTE 375/575 Academic and Career Planning Introduction and Implementation, for participants at the fall 2017 DPI Academic and Career Planning Leadership Conference, “ACP: Equipping Today’s Students for Tomorrow’s Opportunities” on August 21-22, 2017.

Course Description: Study of the Academic and Career Planning (ACP) process in Wisconsin. Distinguish between the ACP Process that helps students engage in academic and career development activities and the PRODUCT that is created and maintained for student’s academic, career, and personal advancement. Examine shifts in thinking, approach, and delivery of career development necessary for successful ACP implementation within local school districts. Participants should **register by August 12** for UW-Stout credit to have access to course resources in time to complete the first assignment due on August 20.

This course will start prior to ACP Leadership Conference on August 14 because participants who enroll in this course will be expected to familiarize yourself with Academic and Career Planning language, research, and the process to be used in Wisconsin and write a short reflection paper (~3 pages) on learning from these materials, using the following questions as a guide:

- What is the vision for Academic and Career Planning in Wisconsin?
- What is the intent of this initiative, and who should be involved in moving it forward?
- What questions, concerns, or ideas did these materials raise that you hope will be addressed through the conference sessions?

First Assignment Deadline is due prior to conference: Midnight, August 20
