Suggested Follow-Up Discussion Questions**



Webinar Recap:

The December 16th webinar discussed one way to prepare teachers to embed ACP in the classroom--teacher externships. The webinar ended with an invitation for districts to create a plan to better prepare their teachers to address ACP as they deliver their content and to better understand career pathways for their students and how those pathways align to their curricula.

Suggested Follow-Up Discussion Questions:

- What alternative methods might you use to prepare teachers to get exposure to a viable ACP opportunity?
- What are your talking points to start the conversation to begin an externship experience?
- What barriers do you see in our area that might influence participation and what tactics might be used to help overcome these barriers?
- Who are your potential partners (businesses, post-secondary institutions, etc). What businesses does your district already have pre established relationships with?
- Who isn't at the table? What individuals might be a positive influence on the success of an externship experience?
- What stood out to you from Randy and Katie that might inspire you or other teachers to participate in the program? (What could districts do to motivate teachers to participate in an externship program?)
- Are there company options that may give you a variety of opportunities within one company? How might this impact your view of an experience?
- How could an teacher externship translate into a more equitable educational experience for students?
