# ACP Resource Roadmap

As the evaluators for the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction's (DPI) Academic & Career Planning (ACP) program, the Wisconsin Evaluation Collaborative (WEC) has been conducting case studies and surveying educators around the state for six years. In the 2021 statewide survey, ACP coordinators, principals, counselors and others were asked what they would most like to learn from evaluation efforts. This brief aims to acknowledge and share the feedback on this question reported by Wisconsin educators, to highlight existing resources, and to indicate future areas of focus exploring questions of interest to ACP stakeholders.

# Educator Requests for Resources

One hundred forty-five educators from throughout the state contributed ideas covering a broad range of topics. A number of the topics and requests for information and resources have already been addressed in previous evaluation reports, special publications, toolkits and workshops.
