Whereas, the success of this effort is due largely to resourceful and creative local food service administrators, managers, and staff working in cooperation with parents, teachers, community groups, government personnel, and students;

Sherefore, be it resolved that, I, Carolyn Stanford Taylor, State Superintendent of Public Instruction, declare October 12-16, 2020, National School Lunch Week, a time to celebrate the importance of a program helping keep students nourished, so they can learn.
