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VIRTUAL CHARTER SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS (cont'd)

L Informs the parent or guardian of each pupil attending the virtual charter school, in writing, the name of and how to contact, each of the following persons: [Wis. Stats. § 118.40 (8) (f)]

- The members of the school board that contracted for the establishment of the virtual charter school and the administrators of that school district.
- The members of the virtual charter school's governing body.
- The members of the virtual charter school's parent advisory council.
- The staff of the virtual charter school.

Whenever a pupil attending the school fails to respond appropriately to a school assignment or directive from instructional staff within five school days, the governing body of the school notifies the pupil's parent or guardian. The third time this occurs in a semester, the governing body of the school also notifies the school board contracted for the establishment of the school, the school board of the pupil's resident school district, and the department. [Wis. Stats. § 118.40 (8) (g)]

[If a pupil's parent or guardian notifies the school in writing that the pupil will be unavailable during a specified period prior to an assignment or directive being given, the school days during that period do not count toward the five-day response requirement and the required notifications to the appropriate school boards and the department. However, the school requires the pupil to complete any assignment missed during the period. This only applies to up to 10 school days in a school year.]
