Subject:	Licensure Required to Lead a School District

The department recently published an <u>information bulletin</u> regarding licensure to lead a school district. The bulletin addresses the following questions:

- If a district hired a business manager or principal to lead the district how can they get licensed as a district administrator?
- What does the district need to do if hiring someone to lead the district who has a license other than a district administrator license?
