The Department of Public Instruction (DPI) has opened a survey to gather comments on the existing <u>Wisconsin Common Career Technical Standards</u> (<u>WCCTS</u>). The WCCTS provide a foundation on which other career and technical subject-specific standards are built. These employability or "future-ready" skills a

subject-specific standards are built. These employability or "future-ready" skills are founded on social-emotional learning, global competence, STEM skills, and digital literacy skills and include the following.

- Creativity, critical thinking, communication, and collaboration
- Career development
- Environment, health, and safety
- Global and cultural awareness
- Information, media, and technology
- Leadership

<u>The survey</u> will be open through August 11. Please let us know what you think so that DPI can make a decision about these standards that makes sense for Wisconsin students and educators. NOTE: <u>CTE subject-specific surveys</u> are also available and include questions related to the WCCTS. Therefore, you do not need to complete this survey if you have completed or plan to complete a subject-specific survey.
