Please read below for important deadline reminders related to statewide ACT testing.

### Submit ACT Accommodations and English Learner Supports in TAA: Due January 20

- Submit ACT accommodations and supports through the [Test Accessibility and Accommodations System](#) (TAA) by Friday, January 20. ***This is a firm deadline.***
- See the [Wisconsin ACT Webpage, Step 3 – Accommodations](#) for assistance entering accommodation requests.
- Log into TAA to view decisions on accommodations requests. If you are unsure about what documentation to submit, contact the ACT Accommodations team at 800-553-6244 x1788 or [actstateaccoms@act.org](mailto:actstateaccoms@act.org).
  - If a request is not approved, you can submit additional documentation to support your request through **February 3**
  - Reach out to DPI as soon as possible if you are experiencing difficulty receiving approval for an accommodation.
- [Qualified Exceptions to the Deadline](#) (formally Late Consideration) of accommodations will be permitted through March 3 **only for students who:**
  - transfer to your school after January 20
  - are newly classified as grade 11 after January 20,
  - have a sudden onset of a medical emergency after January 20, or
  - have been newly evaluated and started on new accommodations/EL supports after January 20.
