Please read below for important information about deadlines

and updates related to statewide ACT and ACT Aspire testing.

ACT

Student Roster Upload: January 19

- Today, January 19, DPI will load student names from WISEdata into PAnext.
- School staff will have from January 20-22 to verify that student information is correct.
 - Please see the <u>Verifying Student Roster and Testing Format Guide</u> on DPI ACT Resources webpage.
- Barcode labels and test materials will be shipped only for students who are in PAnext at
 the end of the day on January 22. After January 22, schools can add new students, but they
 will not receive barcodes or test materials for those students automatically. Schools will
 need to follow the instructions in the test administration and PAnext manuals on how to
 prepare an answer document without a barcode and order additional testing materials.

Request for accommodation/ELL support reconsideration - Deadline January 22.

- The deadline to enter accommodation/ELL supports closed on January 15.
- Log into TAA to view status and decisions on accommodations/ELL support requests.
- ACT includes notes about what documentation is needed to approve the request.
 Download the Decision Notification in TAA and read these notes so you can see what has been approved and where additional documentation is necessary.

- If a request is not approved, you can submit additional documentation to support your request through **January 22**.

Extended 2021 Aspire Testing Window

2021 Aspire Administration:

The Aspire PAnext portal will open for the 2021 assessment on January 25. All 2021 Aspire Administration manuals and supplements have been posted and are available to download under the Administration section of the Wisconsin ACT Website.

To Do:

- Bookmark the <u>ACT Aspire PearsonAccess</u> webpage for easy access in the future. It will be helpful to name it with ACT Aspire to keep the platform separate from ACT with writing.
- Review the <u>PearsonAccessNext System Overview</u> to understand its basic functionality (Note: Wisconsin has specific customization that differs from the slideshow, including: home page, test dates, and User Role Matrix).
- New Testing Staff: On January 25, look for an email from PearsonAccess
 (NoReplyAspire@act.org) with a subject line of ACT Aspire Account Access: New
 Account. This email may be in your spam or junk folders, if not in your inbox. Follow the
 instructions in the email to finish setting up your account. This will be an invite into the
 Production site.
- On January 25, new users will also receive an invitation into the Aspire *training* site, https://training.aspire.act.org, featuring a brown banner. The *training* site can be used to run a mock administration or test your technical infrastructure.
- Bookmark the Wisconsin ACT Website to refer to the many resources it offers.
- Review the updated <u>2021 ACT Aspire Schedule of Events</u>. It lists activities to complete, who completes the activity, and important deadlines.
- Review the <u>User Role Matrix</u>, specific for Wisconsin schools, before inviting new users to determine who receives which role. Then you can invite new users following procedures on page 42 of the <u>Aspire Tests Coordinator Manual</u>.
- Register for Aspire training webinars.
