Please read below for important deadline reminders related to statewide ACT testing.

Submit ACT Accommodations and English Learner Supports in TAA: Due January 24

- Submit ACT accommodations and supports through the [Test Accessibility and Accommodations System](#) (TAA) by **Friday, January 24**. *This is a firm deadline.*
 - See the [Wisconsin ACT Webpage, Step 3 – Accommodations](#) for all resources and tutorials on how to submit accommodation requests.
- Log into TAA to view decisions on accommodations requests and to confirm all student requests have been submitted. If you are unsure about what documentation to submit, contact the ACT Accommodations team at 800-553-6244 x1788.
 - If a request submitted by the deadline is not approved, you can submit additional documentation to support your request through **January 31**.
 - Reach out to DPI as soon as possible if you are experiencing difficulty receiving approval for an accommodation.
- [Qualified Exceptions to the Deadline](#) (formally Late Consideration) of accommodations will be permitted through March 7 for Test Window 1 *only for students who*:
 - transfer to your school after January 24
 - are newly classified as grade 11 after January 24,
 - have a sudden onset of a medical emergency after January 24, or
 - have been newly evaluated and started on new accommodations/EL supports after January 24.
