ACT Reporting

As a reminder, school and district ACT Profile Reports and Student Data files are now available in the [ACT PearsonAccessNext \(PAnext\)](#) portal. Data can also be pulled down through ACT's online reporting in Success.ACT. To access Profile Reports and Student Data files in PAnext, please review the instructions outlined in the PAnext User Guide. For assistance with accessing data through online reporting in Success.ACT, please review the ACT Online Reporting User Supplement. Additional reporting resources and training can be found on the Wisconsin ACT Website.

Aspire Reporting

Reports will be available in the Aspire PAnext portal on June 29. Schools should download and print Individual Student Reports (ISRs) and distribute them to students and families. When sending Individual Student Reports (ISRs) home, districts should make use of the resources created to help parents/guardians understand their child's Aspire results. The Understanding Your ACT Aspire Summative Results Guide for students (English, Spanish) and Sample Cover Letter (English, Spanish and Hmong) are located on the DPI Aspire Data and Results webpage. There are also several additional school and district reports that can be retrieved from the portal including skill and subject proficiencies by groups, by demographics, and by student. The Summative Reports Guide lists all the reports that are available. Reporting resources can be found on the Wisconsin ACT Aspire webpage.
