

Entering Fractions and Mixed Numbers

On the Badger Exam students have two ways to enter a mixed number, using the embedded keypad or an external keyboard.

Using the embedded keypad to enter a mixed number

Students must enter the whole number first then press the horizontal bracket (highlighted below) on the keypad. This will provide a space.



Students can then press the fraction button (highlighted below) and enter the fraction to complete their mixed number response.



Using the external keyboard to enter a mixed number

Students can enter the whole number and press the **space bar**. This will provide a space. Students can then enter the numerator, hit the “?” key which creates the fraction, and complete the response by entering the denominator.
