## Assessment

### Reminder:

#### Verify Student Data

DPI will load student data from WISEdata into the DRC INSIGHT Portal (Forward) and PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup> (ACT with writing and PreACT Secure). To ensure that you have the correct roster of students for testing, please make certain that your student enrollment and demographic data are correct in WISEdata before the end of the day on January 25.

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## ACCESS for ELLs

### New:

#### Materials

The last day to order Additional Materials is January 26. All materials are due back to DRC on or before Tuesday, February 13. Please ensure that UPS picks up your materials by Friday, February 9 to meet this deadline.

### Reminder:

#### Student Transfers

If you have a student transfer into your district from another Wisconsin district, please complete the [Student Transfer Request for ACCESS for ELLs form](#). We will transfer their registration to your district, and the student will not need to be administered any domains they have already completed.

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## ACT

### New:

#### Online Testing Site Readiness Service

On January 15, ACT will begin their outreach to schools and districts who opted into ACT's Online Testing Site Readiness Service. DACs should continue to monitor emails and calls from this service.



**Reminder:****Accommodation Requests Reminder**

The deadline to submit requests for spring 2024 testing is **January 19**. DPI strongly encourages schools to **enter requests into the Test Accessibility and Accommodations System (TAA) now** to avoid delays and allow time for reconsideration if needed.

- Submit requests early - well before the **January 19 deadline**.
  - Refer to [Step 3: Accommodation, on the Wisconsin ACT Webpage](#) for accommodation and EL support resources and training.
  - Log into the TAA to view status and decisions on accommodations/EL support requests.
    - If a request is not approved, you can submit again for reconsideration.
    - [Reach out to OEA](#) as soon as possible if you are experiencing difficulty receiving an approval for an accommodation.

In order for a teacher to be able to administer the DLM they need to complete the required teacher training. Teachers who are new to DLM or did not complete training last year need to complete the new teacher training. Returning teachers who completed the training last year need to complete the returning teacher training this year. Please encourage teachers to complete the training as soon as possible.

In order for teachers to complete the first contact surveys, students need to be rostered to the teachers. #### NAEP Assessment Management System (AMS) Updates

Automatic emails have been going out from the NAEP AMS to designated NAEP School Coordinators to remind them of upcoming tasks. **NAEP High School Transcript Study Open Through January 31**

The NAEP High School Transcript Study (HSTS) data collection is now open in the [NAEP Assessment Management System \(AMS\)](#). HSTS Coordinators will complete the course catalog submission and the transcript information survey, which are open through the **end of January**. The last step of the HSTS is the student transcript submission which will open in the summer of 2024.
