WISCONSIN FORWARD EXAM AGREEMENT TO MAINTAIN SECURITY & CONFIDENTIALITY

When a student cannot access text-to-speech, an embedded resource available on the Forward Exam, the student may be eligible to work with a test reader.

On the Forward Exam:

- Test readers are allowable across all grades as a designated support for Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and English Language Arts (ELA) items as appropriate (**not ELA Session 1 reading comprehension passages**).
- Test readers are allowable for ELA reading passages as a documented accommodation only for newly blind students who are not yet proficient in Braille (must have IEP/504 plan).
- Test readers should adhere to the *Forward Exam Guidelines for Read Aloud* to ensure that the read-aloud is standardized.
