Reminder:

Verify Student Data

DPI will load student data from WISEdata into the DRC INSIGHT Portal (Forward) and PearsonAccess^{next} (ACT with writing and PreACT Secure). To ensure that you have the correct roster of students for testing, please make certain that your student enrollment and demographic data are correct in WISEdata before the end of the day on January 25.

Additional Steps Needed to Order the ACT for Non-Choice Students

Listed below are the complete list of steps necessary for schools to order the ACT with Writing for their non-choice students.

- Complete the DPI order form by the January 19 deadline. This step is to notify DPI whether a school plans on testing non-choice students.
- Verify that DPI has loaded your choice students (and non-choice students from schools that are receiving the all school report card) into the portal (January 29-31 window to complete this step).
- Once choice students have been verified as being loaded, school staff will be able to upload
 any additional 11th grade non-choice students into the portal that plan on testing (January
 29-31 window to complete this step). This step is to let ACT know which students will be
 tested.
- ACT will ship test materials based on the students loaded into PAnext.
- At the conclusion of the testing windows, DPI will contact schools to ask them to verify the
 actual number of non-choice students that were tested. DPI will then bill schools based on
 this updated information.

Student Roster Verification and Upload: January 29-31

- Assessment coordinators will receive an email next week with instructions on how to upload any additional students (choice or non-choice) who were not included in the initial DPI upload. School staff will be able to upload these additional students into PAnext from January 29-31.
- Coordinators will be able to indicate the testing mode (paper or online) for each student.
- Barcode labels will be shipped only for students who are in PAnext at the end of the day on January 31. After January 31, schools can add new students, but they will not receive barcodes and schools will need to follow the instructions in the test administration manuals on how to prepare an answer document without a barcode.

Online Testing Site Readiness Service

On January 15, ACT will begin their outreach to schools and districts who opted into ACT's Online Testing Site Readiness Service. DACs should continue to monitor emails and calls from this service.

Reminder:

ACT with Writing for Non-Choice Students

Non-choice students will again be allowed to take the ACT with Writing on the state administration dates. Cost for the test will be \$54.25 per student. Order deadline is set for January 19.

Accommodation Requests Reminder

The deadline to submit requests for spring 2024 testing is **January 19**. DPI strongly encourages schools to **enter requests into the Test Accessibility and Accommodations System (TAA) now** to avoid delays and allow time for reconsideration if needed.

- Submit requests early well before the January 19 deadline.
- Refer to <u>Step 3: Accommodation</u>, on the <u>Wisconsin ACT Webpage</u> for accommodation and EL support resources and training.
- Log into the TAA to view status and decisions on accommodations/EL support requests.
 - If a request is not approved, you can submit again for reconsideration.
 - Reach out to OEA as soon as possible if you are experiencing difficulty receiving an approval for an accommodation.

PreACT Secure

PreACT Secure for Non-Choice Students

9th and 10th grade non-choice students will again be allowed to take the PreACT Secure under the state contract. Cost for the test will be \$18 per student. Order deadline is set for January 19.

Forward Exam for Non-Choice Students

Non-Choice students will again be able to take the Forward Exam with the cost of the exam remaining at \$35 per student. The order form can be found at <u>Forward Exam Order Form</u>.

practice with the online Forward Exam Practice test as new tools and functionality have been included (e.g., Text-to-Speech Universal Tool for all students). <u>Updated Student Tutorials</u> are also now available and should be used in conjunction with the practice test.
