## **ACT**

#### New:

#### Additional Steps Needed to Order the ACT for Non-Choice Students

Listed below are the complete list of steps necessary for schools to order the ACT with Writing for their non-choice students.

- Complete the order form by the January 13 deadline. This step is to notify DPI whether a school plans on testing non-choice students.
- Verify that DPI has loaded your choice students (and non-choice students from schools that are receiving the all school report card) into the portal (January 23-25 window to complete this step).
- Once choice students have been verified as being loaded, school staff will be able to upload
  any additional 11<sup>th</sup> grade non-choice students into the portal that plan on testing (January
  23-25 window to complete this step). This step is to let ACT know which students will be
  tested.
- ACT will ship test materials based on the students loaded into PAnext.
- At the conclusion of the testing windows, DPI will contact schools to ask them to verify the
  actual number of non-choice students that were tested. DPI will then bill schools based on
  this updated information.

#### **Student Roster Upload: January 23-25**

- Assessment coordinators will receive an email later today with instructions on how to
  upload any additional students (choice or non-choice) who were not included in the initial
  DPI upload. School staff will be able to upload these additional students into PAnext from
  January 23-25.
- Barcode labels will be shipped only for students who are in PAnext at the end of the day on January 25. After January 25, schools can add new students, but they will not receive barcodes and schools will need to follow the instructions in the test administration manuals on how to prepare an answer document without a barcode.

#### Test Accessibility and Accommodations (TAA) Update

DPI has been informed that ACT deployed a repair to the Test Accessibility and Accommodations System (TAA) that has greatly improved system performance. Schools should now be able to successfully submit requests for accommodations and English Learner supports. #### **Accommodation Request Deadline Extended**

As a result of the TAA performance issues, DPI has worked with ACT to extend the deadline to request accommodations. The new deadline to submit requests for spring 2023 testing is January 20. DPI strongly encourages schools to enter requests into TAA as soon as possible.

#### **Accommodation Request Reminders and Resources**

- Submit requests early well before the January 20 deadline.
- Refer to <u>Step-3: Accommodation</u>, on the <u>Wisconsin ACT Webpage</u> for accommodation and EL support resources and training.
- Log into the TAA to view status and decisions on accommodations/EL support requests.
  - o If a request is not approved, you can submit again for reconsideration.
  - Reach out to OSA as soon as possible if you are experiencing difficulty receiving approval for an accommodation.

#### **PreACT Secure for Non-Choice Students**

9th and 10th grade non-choice students will be allowed to take the PreACT Secure under the state contract (similar to how 11th grade non-choice students have been able to take the ACT under the state contract the last several years). Cost for the test will be \$17 per student. Order forms were sent to assessment coordinators on December 8. The deadline to place an order is set for January 13.

## **Forward Exam**

## New:

#### 2023 Optional Add Accessibility Features window

The Optional Add Accessibility Features window **provides districts the option** to enter student accessibility features into a district-level student demographic data file and upload the file into the DRC INSIGHT Portal, instead of adding accessibility features on an individual student or "mass assign" basis. Districts may **choose (not required) to use** the Multiple Student Upload (MSU) process to upload this file from February 13-24.    Exam administration and is intended for DACs/SACs who have previously viewed the full
   training and feel comfortable with the process enough to receive only the updates.
- Test Administrator (TA) Training This training is required for all TAs that covers all
  information TAs need to prepare for and administer the Forward Exam. DACs should
  ensure that all TAs view this training.

On January 11 at 1:00 pm, the first of three optional Q&A webinar sessions will take place (see the Forward Exam Calendar webpage for additional dates). This webinar is an opportunity for District and School Assessment Coordinators (DACs/SACs) and District and School Technology Coordinators (DTCs/STCs) to ask DPI and DRC staff questions about Forward Exam test set-up, administration, or technology that may have come up after reviewing the training videos and other resources.
