New:

Requirements for 2023-24 School year

For the 2032-24 school year, Parental Choice Schools will be required to administer to choice pupils the following assessments:

- <u>Wisconsin Forward Exam</u> for English Language Arts and Mathematics assessments in the spring of 2023 for grades 3-8.
- Wisconsin Forward Exam for Science in the spring of 2024 for grades 4 and 8.
- <u>Wisconsin Forward Exam</u> for Social Studies in the spring of 2024 for grades 4, 8 and 10.
- <u>PreACT Secure</u> in the spring of 2024 for 9th and 10th grade.
- The ACT® with writing in the spring of 2024 for 11th grade.

Report Card - Optional Narrative Statement

2024 Accommodation and Support Requests

Schools can begin to enter 2024 accommodation and support requests into the ACT Test Accessibility and Accommodations (TAA) portal beginning **September 11**. Forward Exam

Alignment with New ELA and Mathematics Standards

The spring 2024 Forward Exam for English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics at grades 3-8 will be aligned to the new Wisconsin Standards for ELA (adopted in 2020) and Mathematics (adopted in 2021). Updated Forward Exam Practice Tests will be available in December on the Forward Exam Practice Tests webpage to help students prepare. Please refer to the August 15 DAC Digest, for information on changes to the Forward ELA Exam Design. More information about the newly aligned assessments will be communicated over the next several months.

DAC Contact Updates

New:

Annual DAC and DTC Contact Information Update Forms

The 2023-24 annual <u>District Assessment Coordinator (DAC) and District Technology Coordinator (DTC) Update forms</u> must be submitted by **October 6** to ensure the information is correct for the DPI upload to the vendor portals. These forms are required for both new and returning DACs and DTCs, even if the information has not changed, and must be signed by the District Administrator.

The information provided is used to:

- Ensure DACs and DTCs are on the email lists which will provide them with regular assessment updates throughout the year.
- Upload DAC information into vendor portals to ensure DACs have 2023-24 permissions.

Important notes:

- DACs should remove permissions from and/or make inactive any individuals in vendor portals who are no longer employed by the district and adjust user roles to sync with recent staffing changes.
- If DAC contact changes occur after form submission, a new form should be submitted to name a new or interim DAC.
