**SP 03-2023, CACFP 02-2023, Offsite Monitoring of the Child and Adult Care Food Program and School Meals After the Public Health Emergency Ends (SO, FDCH)**

This [memo](#) announces the expiration of offsite monitoring for the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) after the COVID-19 public health emergency ends. In the event that the public health emergency ends on May 11, on-site monitoring waivers will expire and on-site monitoring requirements will be in effect for all CACFP sponsors on June 10, 2023.

**CACFP 03-2023, Reimbursement for Meals and Snacks Served at Child and Adult Care Food Program Emergency Shelters after the Public Health Emergency Ends (ES)**

This [memo](#) announces that the temporary authorized reimbursement for meals and snacks served to young adults, ages 19 through 24, in emergency shelters participating in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) is

expected to end on May 11, 2023, concurrent with the expiration of the COVID-19 public health emergency. In the event that the emergency ends on May 11, the last day that emergency shelters will be eligible to claim reimbursement for CACFP meals and snacks served to young people over age 18 will be May 11, 2023.
