Subject: New Grant to Increase Participation in Afterschool Meals

Share Our Strength's No Kid Hungry Innovation Team tests promising new models of connecting more kids in need with the federal nutrition programs. Our latest grant opportunity is for schools (or organizations who sponsor schools as sites) serving grades 6 or higher and that already participate in the CACFP At-Risk Afterschool Meal Program. The grant offers \$1,000 to schools to pilot a "campus model" of serving the afterschool meal. For three weeks, grantees must serve the afterschool meal in a central, accessible location in an easy-to-transport package so that kids can move around campus or go directly to their activities with their meal if necessary.
