



Public Notification

This is the public notification of USDA Child Nutrition Program (National School Lunch Program [NSLP], School Breakfast Program [SBP], Child and Adult Care Food Program [CACFP], Summer Food Service Program [SFSP], Special Milk Program [SMP], and Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program [FFVP]) waiver requests.

The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) has submitted the following statewide waivers for the following federal requirements.

- To waive Section 19(b) of the NSLA, thereby allowing SFAs the ability to have parents pick up the FFVP snack without their children present, with the intent that the snack will be given to the eligible children at home. The waiver would allow for SFAs, in good standing, to allow parents/guardians to pick up fresh fruits and vegetables through the FFVP without a student being present. Requested for SY 2021-22; submitted on July 12, 2021, approved July 23, 2021. Valid through June 30, 2022.
- To waive Section 19(a) of the NSLA, thereby permitting SFAs the ability to serve at the best time and the best location, allowing the most successful distribution for the FFVP. Requested for SY 2021-22; submitted on July 12, 2021, approved July 30, 2021. Valid through June 30, 2022.
- To waive the requirement for serving milk in the SMP in a congregate setting for school and non-school sites. Submitted on July 20, 2021, for SY 2021-22, approved August 31, 2021. Valid through June 30, 2022.
- To waive the requirement in the SMP that a student must receive the milk. Requesting that a parent/guardian can pick up the milk without an eligible child present. Requested for school and non-school sites. Submitted on July 20, 2021, for SY 2021-22, approved August 31, 2021. Valid through June 30, 2022.
- To waive the state agency and sponsoring organization monitoring requirements for the NSLP and CACFP, October 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022. Submitted October 15, 2021, approved December 14, 2021. Valid through June 30, 2022 for NSLP monitoring requirements and September 30, 2022 for CACFP monitoring requirements.
- To waive the SFSP requirement that sponsors shall visit each of their sites at least once during the first week of operation under the Program and shall promptly take such actions as are necessary to correct any deficiencies. Requested for all SFSP sponsors for period of May 1, 2022 through April 30, 2023. Waiver submitted on February 28, 2022, approved March 31, 2022. Valid May 1, 2022, through April 30, 2023.
- To waive and extend the statutory and regulatory provisions that authorize the Offer Versus Serve option for school food authorities. Requested for all SFSP sponsors for period of May 1, 2022 through April 30, 2023. Waiver submitted on February 28, 2022, approved March 28, 2022. Valid May 1, 2022, through April 30, 2023.

- To waive SFSP and SSO regulatory requirements of meal service times and duration. Requested for all SFSP sponsors for period of May 1, 2022 through April 30, 2023. Waiver submitted on February 28, 2022, approved March 28, 2022. Valid May 1, 2022, through April 30, 2023.
- To waive SFSP and SSO and extend area eligibility to closed enrolled sites. Requested for all SFSP sponsors for period of May 1, 2022 through April 30, 2023. Waiver submitted on February 28, 2022, approved March 28, 2022. Valid May 1, 2022, through April 30, 2023.
- To waive the state agency and sponsoring organization monitoring requirements for SFSP, May 1, 2022, through September 30, 2022. Waiver submitted March 9, 2022.
- To waive SFSP regulations and allow Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 SFSP sponsors to participate as experienced sponsors during FY 2022. May 1, 2022, through September 30, 2022. Waiver submitted March 9, 2022. Waiver rescinded April 6, 2022.
- To waive current Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) deadlines and extend them so school food authorities have adequate time to gather accurate identified student data. Waiver submitted March 23, 2022, and approved March 28, 2022. Valid through September 30, 2022.
- To waive SFSP regulations and allow WDPI to complete off-site SFSP pre-approval visits during FY 2022. May 1, 2022, through September 30, 2022. Waiver submitted April 6, 2022.
