Dear Private School Representatives,

The Department of Public Instruction is working to implement a federal program called EANS – Emergency Assistance for Non-Public Schools – part of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA). Through this program, eligible schools may receive direct service, assistance, and/or reimbursement of certain costs incurred because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Our EANS webpage lists the [eligibility requirements](#).

Last month, DPI issued [preliminary allocations](#) that indicate how much money would be available for services or assistance for your school. The application window is currently open for schools interested in taking advantage of this EANS Program.

DPI has pre-populated applications with each school's data. At this time, however, DPI does not have an email address associated with your school and therefore cannot send you an application. This may be because your school opted out of DPI communications when completing the PI-1207, or for another reason. **In order to receive an EANS application – which is required to participate in the program – it is important to complete this [EANS Application Request](#) as soon as possible.**

DPI is sending new EANS applications out in batches each week. The application deadline is April 12th.
