To Whom it May Concern:

I am writing this letter to report some improperly reported data for Highland School District (also known as Highland Community Schools). In the 21-22 school year we had 4 students that were marked as not having graduated. The error was brought to our attention as we noticed our average 4- and 7-year cohort graduation rates reported in WISE and shown on State Report Cards decreased from 95% to 85.7%. In the 21-22 school year, there were 30 graduates reported and 5 students who did not graduate. Of the 5 who did not graduate, 3 of the students were international students who never enrolled in another domestic educational program, they were not dropouts.

These changes have been noted in our student information system. We will continue to work with our data team to effectively track student data to effectively meet compliance measures set by the Department of Instruction.
