For the Northwood School District, the data for economically disadvantaged students was not correctly submitted. This is due to a mapping error in our Ed-Fi Code setting during configuration of our student information system (Infinite Campus). According to Infinite Campus, this setting can be easily overlooked by school districts when mapping data. Although we use other data sources to monitor the students that qualify for free and reduced meals, the mapping error in Infinite Campus was not noticed until recently.

Instead of 100% of our students being identified as "Not Economically Disadvantaged" within our school district, the correct date is shown below for the Friday, September 16th, 2022 count used for the following WISEdata snapshot. See attached report that was used to determine this data.

142 Total Students Identified as Economically Disadvantaged:

129 Students Identified as Free Eligibility

13 Students Identified as Reduced Eligibility

Out of the 313 total students enrolled, 142 should be identified and correctly reported as "Economically Disadvantaged".

Please accept this letter as official notification of the error of data. The mapping in Infinite Campus has been correctly set for the 2023-24 school year and will be monitored moving forward into future school years.
