



WISEstaff FTE Guidance

This document provides some general information for the "FTE" data element.

FTE Definition:

Full-time equivalency expressed as a whole number. Must be a whole number > 1 and ≤ 150 (i.e., 100 = full time, 50 = half-time, 75 = $\frac{3}{4}$ time, etc.).

- Required for all agencies except for staff reported with an assignment that has an assignment type of code 2 (Short-Term Substitute/Extra-Curricular Activities).
- The FTE total for each WISEid across agencies must be ≥ 1 and ≤ 150 .

How to Calculate FTE

FTE calculations are used for federal reporting and in average salary calculations. If the FTE data is incorrect, it can throw off average salary data. Please use the formulas below to calculate FTE.

For professionals:

of hours the person works in a year

of hours in the agencies standard work year for that employee's classification

For support staff:

of hours the person works
