As you are aware, Milwaukee Public Schools updated its Board policy regarding attendance at period attendance schools in the 2010-2011 school year. As a result of this policy update, the period attendance data reported to the state during that year did not reflect the correct calculation of daily attendance for period attendance schools. Corrections have been made to the Milwaukee Public Schools data warehouse and are being forwarded to you with this letter to replace the data previously submitted.

It is Milwaukee Public Schools' understanding that DPI does not make corrections to the WINSS data reporting, however, we would like these corrections reflected on the Data Errata Webpage. Additionally, we have developed improved procedures to ensure the accuracy of our reporting.
